

How can I use iglued to better manage a sports team?

One of our main drivers for iglued was to help simplify life for parents whose kids are actively involved in sports. Here's how you can use iglued to manage all of the tasks and activities around a typical sports team.

In this example, we'll use the coach or team mom of a football team to demonstrate iglued's capabilities.

1. Create a group called "Bears Football"
2. **Team roster** – Enter all players and parents in address book and assign them to Bears Football group. Everyone in the group will now have access to all information associated to this group when they sign into their iglued site.
3. **Practices and Games** – Enter practices and game schedule into Calendar. All this information will automatically appear in each person's own iglued calendar on their own iglued site.
4. **Messaging or Comments** – use either of these features to communicate with people in your group.
5. **Memories** – This is the area where parents can upload game photos to share with others.
6. **Bulletin Board** – Helps you prepare and plan for parties by allowing you to list and track to-do items.
7. **Volunteer Event.** Take the stress out of filling and managing volunteer slots! Create a list of volunteers needed for game day. Make it easy for all parents to see specific areas of need. Easily communicate the responsibilities of each volunteer position. Simplify the process for communicating and managing volunteer activities and commitments via calendars and automated reminders.
8. **Coming soon – Instant Notifications** How many times has this happened to you? You need to quickly notify all parents that practice has been cancelled. Trouble is, you're stuck in traffic or away from home! Not a problem. Simply access iglued from your phone, enter your message and all parents will instantly receive a voice message letting them know about the cancelled practice. Parents who are not home at that moment will also instantly receive an SMS text message on their phone. No more wasted trips to the field. No more stressful last-minute calling.
